Rowers can register for regattas, programs, clubs, camps, clinics, volunteer, and view results from regatta events. Tens of thousands of visitors from all over the world sign up for regattas via regattacentral.com.

Business Challenges

RegattaCentral gained traction in the global rowing community, with a high number of rowers frequently registering for regattas. For big races, traffic to the website could exceed 90,000 visitors, with entries from over 30 countries. Such surges in traffic proved to be too much for RegattaCentral's dedicated servers, responsible for distributing statically and dynamically stored content to club members and registrants, worldwide.

Before minor issues in performance could become major issues, the rowing source's Founder, President and Chief Architect, Steve Lopez, took action to make improvements. "My goal was to improve the perceived responsiveness of the website by offloading the content and pushing it on a different domain or subdomain. We allow clubs and regattas to edit their pages and users to upload their registration forms to our servers. We have a lot of static content, but it's dynamic in a sense that it's pushed out by our users," said Lopez. Since traffic to RegattaCentral spiked in accordance to regatta registration, Lopez knew that a scalable Content Delivery Network (CDN) was needed to seamlessly accommodate traffic on-demand.
